Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) of Merced County is accepting applications for its "Alternate Public Member" position. This position has a term of four years. Since the commission seeks balanced representation from within the county and the existing public member is from western Merced County, we are seeking applicants who live east of the San Joaquin River.

The LAFCO Commission is chartered under State law to review and act upon proposals that establish or alter the boundary and the functions of various local government agencies within the County. Examples of such proposals include annexations to cities and boundary changes to rural irrigation districts, urban service districts, and the formation of new special districts.

The Commission consists of five regular members and three alternate members including:

The application submittal deadline is at 4:30 p.m. July 19, 2006.
